RE: Reaffirmation of Regional Center Designation

DECISION


This notice is in reference to the regional center designation of Golden Lamp Regional Center, Inc. ("GLRC"), which was initially issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS") on August 23, 2011. Upon designation, USCIS authorized the regional center's participation in the Immigrant Investor Program (the "Program") pursuant to section 610 of the Departments of Commerce, Justice and State, the Judiciary, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 1993, Pub. L. 102-395, as amended ("Public Law 102-395").¹ Pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 204.6(m)(6), regional centers must demonstrate continued eligibility for regional center designation and are required to file Form I-924A, Supplement to Form I-924 ("Form I-924A") on an annual basis.

On June 19, 2015 USCIS notified GLRC of its intent, pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 204.6(m)(6), to terminate its participation as a regional center in the Program for failure to report in its I-924A filings any EB-5 capital investment or job creation for fiscal years 2011, 2012, 2013, or 2014. The Notice of Intent to Terminate ("ITT") provided GLRC an opportunity to offer evidence in opposition to the grounds alleged in the ITT.

¹ On September 28, 2012, President Obama signed into law Senate bill S. 3245, which amended section 610 of Public Law 102-395. S. 3245 struck the word "pilot" from section 610 of Public Law 102-395 and extended the Immigrant Investor Program until September 30, 2015.

On July 23, 2015 and August 5, 2015, in response to the ITT, USCIS received evidence from GLRC, and after considering the evidence, USCIS reaffirms the existing regional center designation for GLRC.
